Notes: (a) full name of applicant or club; (b) description of the proposed variation(s), including, if applicable, activities and hours sought, and any other relevant information; (c) name of premises or club; (d) address of premises; (e) the last date for comments should be written in the format dd/mm/yyyy and calculated as 10 working days, starting the first working day following the date of application and ending on the 10th working day.

Please note that the Window Notice must be printed on white paper of at least A4 size and printed legibly in black ink. The text on the Notice must remain in a Size 16 Times New Roman font. The header information must specify whether application is in respect of a premises licence or club premises certificate and must remain in Size 32 Times New Roman font
