Clay Critters

Make your own woodland creature from clay and found natural items in your local park or woods.

Suitable for all ages.

Take a small lump of clay – about the size of a lime - and roll it into a ball.

Then form the clay into the body shape of the animal you want to make – e.g. round for a hedgehog, cylinder for mouse or owl.

Collect natural items to make the features of your animal – eyes, ears, tails, wings, spines etc. Seeds, sticks, leaves, bark and stones are all great. Remember not to pick any living things!

Push the natural items into your clay to create your animal. You can also decorate the clay using a stick to make marks to finish your creation.
