Kensington Park Road Junction with Chepstow Villas and Kensington Park Gardens


A tiger crossing (a combination of a zebra crossing and a cycle crossing) over Kensington Park Road prioritises cyclists and pedestrians over vehicles.

Segregated cycle lanes on the approach to the tiger crossing from Kensington Park Gardens and Chepstow Villas will actively promote connectivity for cyclists.

Carriageway narrowing on side streets and introduction of one way streets allow for wide pavement build outs can be animated by street furniture and planting.
