- Jug of water
- Spoon
- 8 small pieces of paper
- Pen or pencil

Using the jug, fill the glasses with the amounts of water shown in the picture. Glass 1 will have the most and glass 8 the least.

Using the spoon to tap the glasses in the following order, try playing 'Twinkle,
Twinkle, Little Star'.
