SUBMISSION OF PLANS

Where plans are required to be submitted as part of an application for a Gambling Premises Licence, they **must** be submitted in accordance with the requirements of the respective Regulation Orders. These requirements are specified in the table shown below.

<u>Please Note:</u> Failure to comply with the requirements as specified, will render the application incomplete and will result in the whole application being rejected and returned to you.

PLAN REQUIREMENTS

The plan must be to scale and must:

- (a) The extent of the boundary or perimeter of the premises.
- (b) Where the premises include, or consist of, one or more buildings, the location of any external or internal walls of each such building.
- (c) Where the premises form part of a building, the location of any external or internal walls of the building which are included in the premises
- (d) Where the premises are a vessel or a part of a vessel, the location of any part of the sides of the vessel, and of any internal walls of the vessel, which are included in the premises
- (e) The location of each point of entry to and exit from the premises, including in each case a description of the place from which entry is made or to which the exit leads

In respect of Casinos

- (f) The principal entrance to the premises of those identified in accordance with paragraph (e) above
- (g) The location and extent of any part of the premises which will be a table gaming area
- (h) The location and extent of any other part of the premises which will be used for providing facilities for gambling in reliance on the licence
- (i) The location and extent of any part of the premises which will be a non-gambling area.

In respect of Bingo premises to which children or young persons will have access

- (j) The location and extent of any part of the premises which will be used to provide facilities for gaming in reliance on the licence (other than those parts which include Category B or C gaming machines
- (k) The location and extent of any part of the premises in which Category B or C gaming machines will be made available for use in reliance on the licence
- (1) The nature and location of any barrier or other thing separating any part of the premises in which Category B or C gaming machines will be made available for use from any other part of the premises.

In respect of **Adult Gaming Centres**

(m) The location and extent of any part of the premises in which gaming machines will be made available for use in reliance on the licence

In respect of Family Entertainment Centres

- (n) The location and extent of any part of the premises in which Category C gaming machines will be made available for use in reliance on the licence
- (o) The location and extent of any part of the premises in which Category D gaming machines will be made available for use in reliance on the licence
- (p) The nature and location of any barrier or other thing separating any part of the premises in which Category C gaming machines will be made available for use from any other part of the premises.

In respect of **Betting Premises** (other than Betting Tracks)

(q) The location and extent of any part of the premises which will be used to provide facilities for gambling in reliance on the licence
