Salt Dough Creatures

Make models of your favourite minibeasts.

This is an indoor activity.



Mix the salt, flour and water together. You should get sticky dough.

Kit List

- 1 cup of flour
- ¹⁄₂ cup of water
- \circ $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of salt
- Bowl and spoon
- Baking tray with baking paper or greased
- Oven or warm cupboard or windowsill
- Pencil or sticks for making marks
- Optional: paints or colouring pens

step Two

Decide what you are going to make and use the dough in your hands to make the shape of the animal.

Step

Use the pencil or sticks to make detail on the surface of the creature, such as eyes or scales. Legs and antennae could be made with sticks or pipe cleaners.

Step

Put the finished animal to dry on a tray, this can be in a warm (not hot) oven, or a warm windowsill or airing cupboard.

Once your animal is fully dry, they will be hard and you can paint them if you like! If you keep them dry they will last a long time.
