Tree Faces

Create a face on a tree from natural materials.

This is an outdoor activity for all ages.

Step One

step Two Whilst on a walk in a park or woods, find a tree that you want to decorate with a face.

If you're making mud, mix a little water with some soil in a container until it is squidgy and mouldable.

Roll your clay, play dough or mud into a ball and then use your hands to squidge it on to the bark of the tree.

Step Three

Collect natural objects to create the features of your face – small sticks, feathers, little stones, seeds, leaves, berries are all good. Remember to collect things that have fallen and not to pick anything off a living plant.

Step Four

Squish the things you have collected into the clay/play dough/mud to make the eyes, ears, nose, mouth and other features of your face.

Will you make a person, an animal or a made-up creature?

If you want to make mud you'll need:

- a bottle of water
- a plastic pot (such as a soup container)



If you've made your face from play dough, please remove it when you've finished. Clay or mud faces can stay if you like.
