

Service Manager - Assessment Services

Job Outline

Main Purpose of Job

- The Head of Assessment Services is responsible for the management of all Adult Social Work and Occupational Therapists employed in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

Key Accountabilities

- Leading a large team, the post holder line manages six heads of department, including the Locality Teams, Hospital Team, Advice Information and Assessment, Reablement and the Transition Team. In addition to this, the Head of Assessment has some joint management responsibility for the Older Peoples Management Team and Memory Service, hosted by CNWL.
- The service provides assessment and provision to vulnerable adults and works closely with children's services the housing department and third sector providers in preventing deterioration in independence and supporting people in staying safe.
- In addition to this, the post holder is required to lead on changes within tri-borough developments, sustaining and managing an effective management presence with the Clinical Commissioning Group and working with Commissioners to develop appropriate provision for the local community.
