In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is given that the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea adopted the Earl's Court and West Kensington Opportunity Area Joint Supplementary Planning Document on **22 March 2012.**
