Main Purpose of the Job

The public highway is a substantial asset and as Director for Transportation and Highways I am responsible for providing a safe and high quality public realm that meets the demands of all road users. I ensure that the road network operates efficiently by coordinating all highway works and ensure that contractors leave the road in a satisfactory condition. I maintain the highway including street lights, traffic signs, parking meters and road markings. I manage kerbside parking space through parking enforcement. I liaise with Transport for London to ensure traffic signal timings are optimised in the borough. I monitor and report on road accidents in the borough and propose road safety measures where appropriate. I am responsible for delivering major capital schemes such as Exhibition Road and Fulham Palace Road, and advise on the predicted traffic and transport implications.
