The Electoral Register

The Electoral Register is a list of all registered voters names and addresses.



It is used to make sure only eligible people can vote.

It is also used for:

- Detecting fraud
- Finding people for jury service
- Checking credit history

The Open Register

The Open Register includes some of the names and addresses from the Electoral Register.



It can be used by people and organisations to check your name and address details.
